SPONSOR A BRICK

Keynsham Parish is raising money to help our link parish of Chipata South, Zambia, build a new Church Primary School.

THE PROJECT. The building will be a 3 classroom block, adapted from the standard government plan. The total cost will be in the region of £20,000. Our friends in Chipata South Parish will raise what funds they can, provide some materials and some labour. There are no government funds available for this project. We in Keynsham Parish will collect and raise as much as we can throughout 2020. A proportion of what we raise will be set aside for pastoral and training costs in Chipata South parish.

THE LEGO CHALLENGE: As funds grow, we will build a scale model in lego of the school. When normal church services resume you can see the model and add a brick yourself (minimum donation of £1.00 per brick). Meanwhile Pip Traynar, our youth worker, will gradually build the model at home, and post pictures on the parish website, just giving page and facebook. WATCH IT GROW!
